- **Age Limit:** As Mentioned above on 1st July 2023

- Since the AACs are IT enabled, i.e., Tablets will be issued to empanelled Medical Officers for prescription of drugs, a self-declaration will be taken w.r.t. knowledge, usage & adoption of IT systems, from the Medical Officer to be empanelled. In case, a candidate refuses the self – declaration, the application will be summarily rejected.
- The Candidates must ensure to bring their original & one self-attested photocopy of documents as mentioned below along with printout of online application form at the time of interview:-

- Office will not be responsible for non receipt of online application of the candidate due to any reason whatsoever.
- Application submitted through online form does not imply that candidate has fulfilled the criteria given in the advertisement and application is subject to

subsequent scrutiny and can be rejected, if candidate does not fulfil the eligibility criteria at any point of time of the empanelment process.
